### **Educational Objectives**

Describe when and how to determine the likelihood of malignancy, and the best method for establishing a definitive diagnosis, including optimal times for follow-up CT studies versus the need to obtain a tissue biopsy.

Describe radiation dose reduction techniques and evaluate current radiation protocols for adults and children.

While using new technologies, apply knowledge of the pathology associated with imaging findings of complex cystic lesions to determine which are most predictive of malignancy.

Apply surgical techniques for new advanced laparoscopic cases, and describe common normal post-op findings vs. common complications of these procedures.

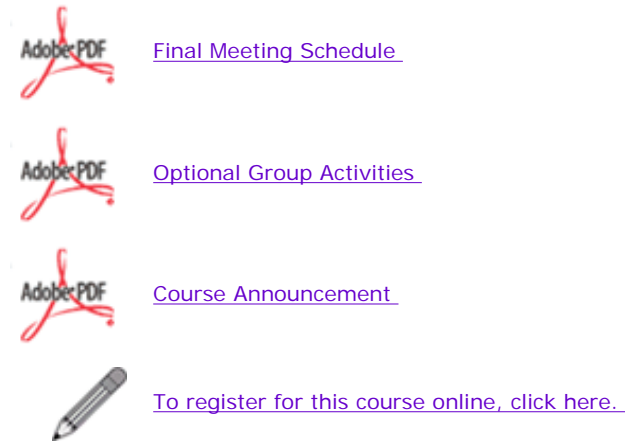
