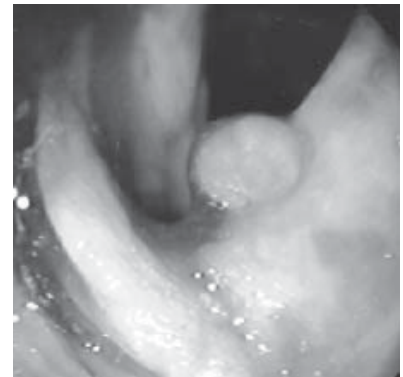
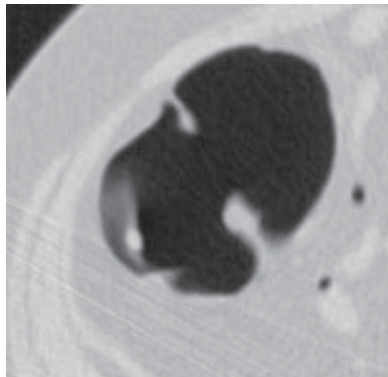
UCSF is pleased to present our workshop on Virtual Colonoscopy. This rapidly evolving technology will be explored in a program with individualized, hands-on workstation training and didactic instruction by Dr. Judy Yee, a leader in this imaging modality.

The program will be held in San Francisco and is scheduled for Thursday afternoon, a full-day on Friday and Saturday morning. By the end of the course the registrant will have reviewed at least 50 proven virtual colonoscopy cases (ABR approved). This instruction meets current recommendations of the American College of Radiology Practice Guidelines.

This workshop will present, to both academic and practicing radiologists, the fundamentals and latest techniques of non-invasive colon cancer screening.

At the end of the workshop, the registrant should be able to:

- perform, interpret and report a virtual colonoscopy exam in a time-efficient manner;
- obtain optimal colonic distention and cleansing for a maximally diagnostic virtual colonoscopy;
- demonstrate a familiarity with common and uncommon pitfalls.

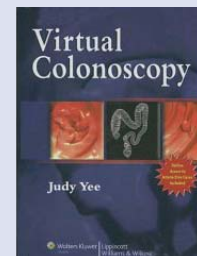

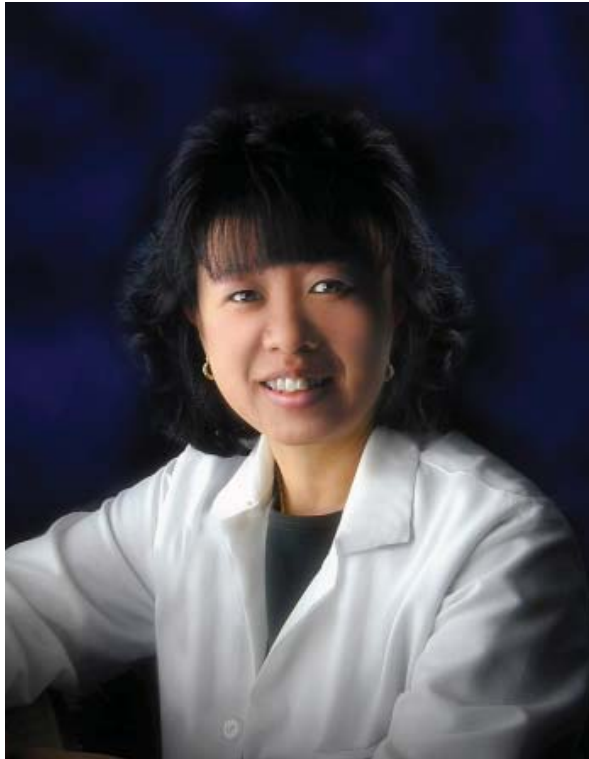
Pre-registration is required as enrollment in this course is limited to 18 registrants. Tuition: \$2,500.

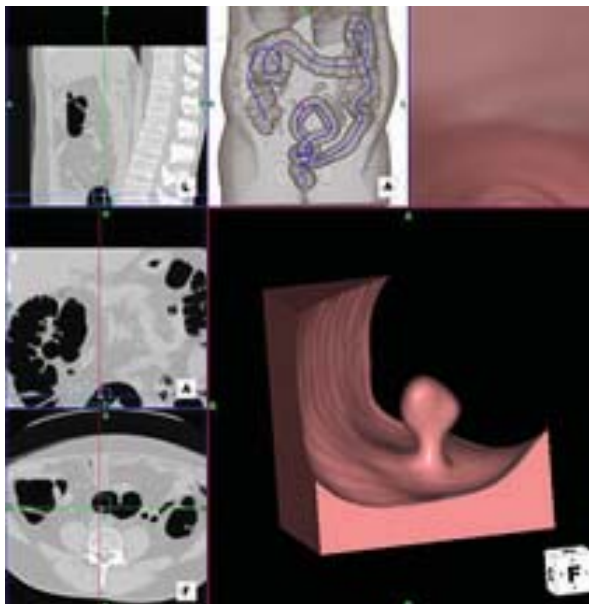

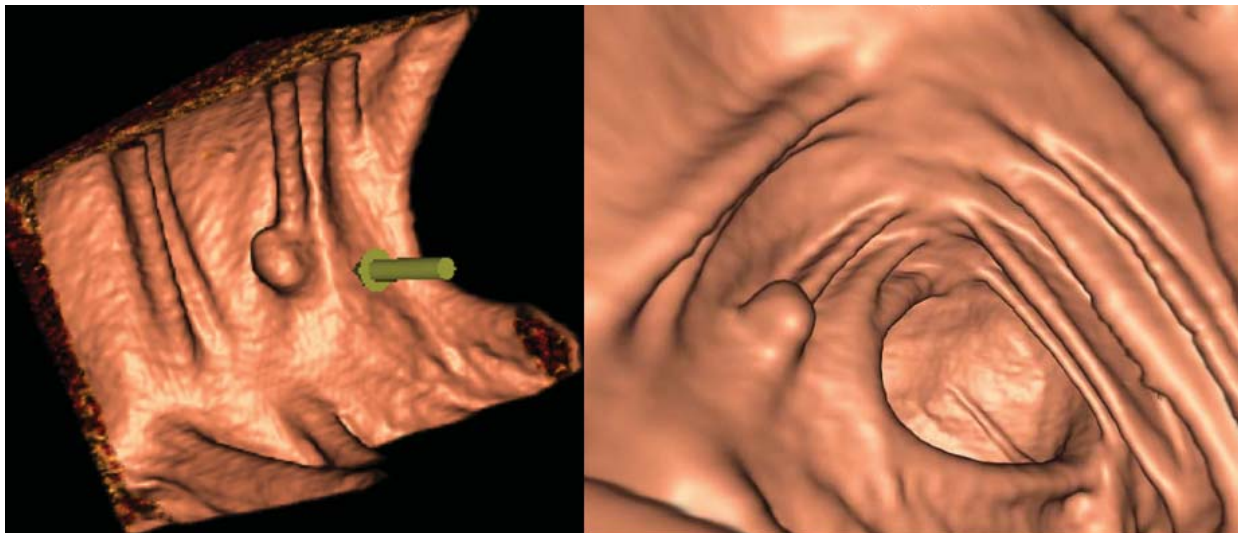

The workshop is held at the UCSF China Basin Research Center at 185 Berry Street, Lobby 6, Third Floor. The Center is located on the southeast side of the city, next to the baseball stadium, and one block from the CalTrain station.

Attendees staying at one of the downtown hotels should note that the China Basin Center is approximately a 20-25 minute walk from Market Street, and is on the N-Judah streetcar line, which is accessible from any of the four underground Market Street Muni stations. The N-Judah stops one short block from the China Basin Center. From the east bay and the peninsula, use BART to connect to any of the four underground Market Street Muni stations. *For more info: www.sfmta.com, www.bart.gov*

For those local to the bay area who will be driving, the entrance to Lobby 6 of China Basin Center is at the corner of Fourth and Berry Streets. Stockton Street (downtown SF) travels one-way south, and becomes Fourth Street after crossing Market. It is recommended that attendees who will be driving use the public underground parking lot beneath the Safeway, one block from China Basin Landing. The garage entrance is on Townsend Street, between Third and Fourth.
